





THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY


yields 6.13 billion square meters of buildings every year, accounting for 39 percent of the world's carbon dioxide emission.

INTERIOR FIT-OUT is responsible for 40% of energy in a building.




FURNITURE contributes to 30% of the carbon footprint of a commercial building over its entire life.

WHAT IS CARBON NEUTRALITY?

Carbon Neutral - or Net Zero Carbon - is a term used to describe the state of an entity where the carbon emissions caused by them have been balanced out by funding an equivalent amount of carbon savings elsewhere in the world.




Climate change is the defining issue of our time.

Each consecutive year of record temperatures, bush fires, drought, flash floods, and rising sea levels sharpens the public's sense of urgency to tackle the climate crisis.

Together, building and construction are responsible for 39% of all carbon emissions in the world and new construction is expected to double the world's building stock by 2060 causing an increase in the carbon emissions occurring right now.

The climate crisis is here and we feel as the creators of tomorrow's workspaces we have an urgent responsibility to embed resilience into our projects.

That's why we've taken the necessary steps towards carbon neutrality.



Recognising the scale and approach we need in combating the existential problem that our planet is currently facing we want to be a catalyst for change in our industry. While we fully acknowledge that we're a long way from perfect, we've taken a big step to understand and reduce our own carbon footprint.

Our carbon neutral plight first began back in 2019 when we became Carbon Assessed, allowing us to identify key areas to focus our reduction efforts.
